Entry Limits & Preference

Entries are limited to 4 hours of judging per judge per show. English Springer Spaniel entries receive priority. For other breeds and mixed breeds, the Event Secretary will hold entries until the closing date and at that time will process other entries, regardless of breed, in order of receipt until the hourly limits are reached. (See Chapter 1, Section 2, of the Obedience Regulations.)

the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.”

- Trial hours: 7:00 a.m.–6:00 p.m. each day.
- Smoking is not permitted in the building or within 20 feet of the doorways.
- The building will be available to exhibitors at 7:15 a.m. on Saturday, December 17. Crates and chairs may remain in the building overnight. Dogs must be removed from the building within 30 minutes after completion of judging each day.
- Because crate space is limited, we’d appreciate your use of stackable crates.
- Crate dogs only in designated areas. Crates or chairs on mats *must* be placed on plastic (supplied by exhibitor).
- Park only in designated areas.
- Bring your own shade and chairs.
- All dogs must be on lead both inside and outside the building except when in the ring.
- The “show grounds” for these trials consists of the show building and the parking lot.
- Judges will not wait for dogs holding up a ring.
- At both the show site and the motels, please pick up after yourselves and your dogs.
- Dumpsters in and around the parking lot cannot be used for any trash.
- Any complaints from motels regarding exhibitors may result in a Trial Committee hearing.
- A dog that bites a person on the Show Grounds may be reported by the Show Committee to Gwinnett County Animal Control.

Notes to Exhibitors

- In accordance with Chapter 1, Section 2, of the *Obedience Regulations*, entry preference is given to English Springer Spaniels, and separate awards will be given to English Springer Spaniels.
- CESSCGA reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- "Effective for all events held on and after January 1, 2008, The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 event service fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.) The current 50 cent recording will continue to be collected. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for the American Kennel Club."—Chapter 11, Section 2 of AKC's *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- No refund will be given for duplicate entries.
- No refund will be given for bitches that come in season after entries close. Bitches in season are not permitted on the show grounds.
- Owners are responsible for accuracy of information on entry forms. After the closing date, no entry fees will be returned in the event of errors or cancellation of entries. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signature.
- Entries not on an official AKC entry form that includes the agreement will not be accepted.
- After November 1, 2011, online entries will be accepted through the club website (www.cesscga.org), with payment through PayPal. Online entries are subject to a small convenience fee; the convenience fee is not refundable if entries are withdrawn before closing.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Event Secretary will add a \$50 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- No entry fee will be refunded for a dog that is absent or is excused or disqualified by the judge or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the club or the Event Secretary.
- Entries submitted by phone will not be accepted.
- Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be submitted in writing and received by the Event Secretary before 6 p.m. on Wednesday, November 30, 2011.
- All checks and money orders must be in U.S. funds.
- Each exhibitor can receive one free catalog by checking the box on the entry form. Catalogs sold at the trials will be \$3 each.
- Indicate 'UDX' if you are entering both Open B & Utility B and you do not want to enter at all if one class or the other is already closed due to entry limitations (*Obedience Regulations*: Chapter 1 Section 27).
- Move-ups will be permitted at these trials. In accordance with Chapter I, Section 16a: "The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to

[1] (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

[2] The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

[3] (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

[4] A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
